

FREE ACT and MME PREPARATION & PRACTICE TESTS

For 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders!

It is never too early to begin practicing for these important standardized tests. Test taking is a learned skill. Remember that acceptance into the college you want to attend is partially determined by the score you earn on the ACT.

1. Go to www.Mel.org and click on a sea foam green bar on the right entitled "Tests and Tutorials (ACT etc.)". Then click on the blue bar on the right that says "new user" and register. Once registration is complete, go to the blue heading "College Entrance Exams" (third one down). Click on "ACT Practice Test". You can either take tests or complete the preparation leading to the tests or just take the practice tests.
2. Go to www.bridges.com/mvhs. Click on the blue box at the right labeled "First Time Users". Click on page 23 at the bottom of the page. Click on "Summit Academy High School". Go to the bottom right and click on "continue page 2/2". Register and click "complete". This will direct you to a page, but ignore it. Instead enter www.bridges.com/mvhs in the web address section. Log in with your new user name and password in the "Test Gear" box at the top right. On the top left, under "Your Tools" click on the arrow in the orange box labeled "Test Gear" and it will open a page with all the tests. Go to the bottom of the page to the heading "Collegiate Entrance Suite" and click on "ACT College Entrance". You will need to take the "Brain Scan" which will take approximately 30 minutes.
