GENERAL FREE SKATE

Open to all levels of skaters working on free skate, moves in the field or dance.

Contract Ice \$7.00
 Walk on \$9.00

LOW FREE SKATE

Open to beginning level skaters working on USFS Basic Skills 1-8 or Free Skate 1-6.

No Double Jumps or Flying Spins

Contract Ice \$3.00
 Walk on \$5.00

POWER

Designed to increase endurance, balance, speed and edge quality of free skate level skaters.

Contract Ice \$7.00
 Walk on \$9.00

MOVES

For skaters working on US Figure Skating Moves in the Field test patterns. All levels of moves skaters are welcome.

NO JUMPS or SPINS on this session.

Contract Ice \$3.50
 Walk on \$5.00

PLEASE READ AND SIGN

THE PEAK @ SUMMIT ACADEMY shall not be liable for any and all claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries or losses of any kind to persons or property which may be sustained in connection with any PEAK ARENA activity.

Recognizing the normal risk of skating on ice, I agree to skate at my own risk and to abide by all skating policies established by the Peak Arena @ Summit Academy, the Peak management and/or professionals. The PEAK ARENA assumes no responsibility for accidents on or off the ice, or damage to personal property.

In the event an emergency situation arises, in which I/we are unable to be contacted or any unavailable for immediate authorization, I/we give permission to _____, or if unavailable, to The PEAK ARENA to arrange for emergency procedures for the contracted skater at a local hospital, or by a physician, and agree to hold all parties harmless.

The PEAK ARENA reserves the right to cancel scheduled events without liability, other than reimbursement credit.

The PEAK ARENA is not responsible for lost, late, stolen or misdirected mail.

The PEAK ARENA is not responsible for typographical errors.

The PEAK ARENA requires that ice contract payments be RECEIVED in the office (NOT POSTMARKED) by the specified date in your contract. NO POSTDATED CHECKS.

Injury Policy

If a skater is unable to skate for 30 or more days due to any injury or illness; they may request that his/her contract be canceled until the skater can resume full skating activities. This request should be in writing with a Doctor's letter indicating the extent of the injury, to document the request. The contracted skater is responsible for paying his/her full contracted ice until the Peak Arena is notified.

PEAK Skaters Policy

1. Skaters must sign in with a Peak Employee at the REGISTRATION DESK before taking the ice for the day.
2. If you are not planning to skate a contracted session, please notify the Peak Employee so someone else may use it.
3. Sessions will be sold after five minutes. EXCEPTIONS: Those skaters whose names have been recorded as having to arrive late.
4. Absolutely no eating, drinking or gum chewing on the ice with the exception of water bottle.
5. Proper respect must be shown to all Professionals, monitors, off ice instructors and parents.
6. Do not interrupt Professionals while they are in a lesson.
7. SKATERS IN A PROGRAM OR LESSON HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY.
8. No foul language or show of temper is allowed.
9. Kicking holes in the ice is inexcusable and you will be asked to leave the ice.
10. All skaters are asked to leave the ice immediately when the ice resurfer driver sounds the buzzer.
11. Dressing rooms and other areas around the arenas are to be left clean and all debris picked up and put in the trash receptacles.
12. NO EQUIPMENT OR CHANGING IN THE CONCESSION AREA, USE THE DRESSING ROOM OR BATHROOMS.
13. Ice is for skating, not visiting. If you must visit, please leave the ice.

Skaters who cannot abide by the above rules may be asked to leave the ice. Their names will be recorded and parents will be called if necessary. Repeated or serious infractions of the rules will be referred to the discipline committee and loss of ice privileges may ensue.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE RULES AND CONDITIONS, AND AGREE TO ADHERE TO THEM. I ALSO UNDERSTAND THAT I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FULL PAYMENT OF THIS CONTRACT REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCE. CONTRACT WILL NOT BE HONORED WITHOUT SIGNATURE.
